SIGHTLIFE EYE BANK, SINCE ITS FOUNDING IN 1969, HAS PROVIDED CORNEAL TISSUE FOR MORE THAN 65,000 SIGHT-RESTORING TRANSPLANTS WORLDWIDE, AND HAS BECOME PROMINENT AS A LEADER AND PARTNER WITHIN THE EYE BANK COMMUNITY. AS ONE OF THE LEADING EYE BANKS IN THE WORLD, IT PROVIDES RECOVERY AND DISTRIBUTION OF CORNEAL TISSUE FOR TRANSPLANT, PROCESSING OF CORNEAL TISSUE FOR SPECIFIC SURGERIES, EYE DONATION SERVICES/EDUCATION, AND DONOR FAMILY SUPPORT PROGRAMS. IT ALSO IS A SIGNIFICANT PROVIDER OF OCULAR TISSUE FOR RESEARCH INTO EYE DISEASES.
